### Award-Winning Classic Holiday Greek Film at the Museum of the Moving Image Sunday, December 14 at 3pm

Astoria, NY – December 2, 2025 – The Hellenic Film Society is pleased to present the Greek cinematic classic, *The Christmas Tango*, as the December screening of [Always on Sunday](#), its monthly Greek film series. The film will be shown on **Sunday, December 14 at 3pm** at the Museum of the Moving Image in Astoria.

The 2011 romantic drama, set on a Greek Army base, is about a lieutenant determined to dance the tango at the holiday party with his colonel's beautiful but unhappy wife with whom he has fallen in love. The film, directed by Nikos Koutelidakis and based on a novel by Yannis Xanthoulis, is the winner of three Hellenic Film Academy Awards.
